

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION IN
“DIPLOMA IN HANDLOOM AND TEXTILE TECHNOLOGY” (DHTT)
INDIAN INSTITUTE OF HANDLOOM TECHNOLOGY, JODHPUR (RAJASTHAN)

(1) Educational qualifications: To be eligible for admission to first year of Diploma Course in Handlooms & Textile Technology, the candidate should have passed 10th standard or equivalent examination with English as a subject of study.

NOTE: Some Board has already introduced the system of grading in 10th Examination. As such candidate must endorse the proof of details of marks with their application form to enable the selection committee to prepare merit list which is prepared on the basis of marks secured in 10th examination only.

(2) Age limit: The age limit for admission to first year of Diploma Course in Handlooms & Textile Technology for all the categories except SC/ST should be between 15-23 years and for SC/ST candidates it should be between 15-25 year as on 01-July of the admission year.

(3) Reservation

- (i) The respective State Governments will follow their reservation policies for SC/ST/OBC etc.
- (ii) In addition to above, minimum 20% of the total seats allotted to the states are reserved for candidates belonging to Weavers Community. Shortfall if any will be met out from the candidates other than weaver's community.

(4) Documents required to fill up the admission form:-

- (i) 10th Mark list.
- (ii) Domicile Certificate of Concern State.
- (iii) Cast Certificate if applicable.
- (iv) Medical Fitness Certificate.
- (v) Passport size photograph.

(5) Seat Distribution for Admission (Intake 50 Students per year of following states):-

- Rajasthan – 16 Seat.
- Haryana – 07 Seat.
- Delhi – 08 Seat.
- Punjab – 03 Seat.
- Gujarat – 06 Seat.
- M.P. – 10 Seat.
