1. \* Details of allotment of seats to different states under the jurisdiction of this institute are given in general instructions.

# The candidates must apply through the departments of the concerned state government.

2. \*\* The candidates will undergo bridge courses for Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry, offered by IIHT Jodhpur.

3. Some Board has already introduced the system of grading in the 10<sup>th</sup>/12<sup>th</sup> Examination. As such candidates must endorse the proof of details of marks with their application form to enable the selection committee to prepare a merit list which is prepared based on marks secured.

**2. Age limit:** The age limit for admission to the first year of the Diploma Course in Handlooms & Textile Technology for all the categories except SC/ST should be between 15-23 years and for SC/ST candidates it should be between 15-25 years as on  $01^{st}$ -July of the admission year. (In case of admission into the direct second year under Lateral Entry, the maximum age limit will be 27 for SC/ST candidates and 25 for other than SC/ST candidates.)

# 4. Numbers of seats and details of the state departments for submitting applications:

# **5.** Applications for admission

The respective state governments will invite applications for admission and the candidate shall submit the application form (Annexed) on or before the date as prescribed by the respective state.

- i. The respective State Governments will follow their reservation policies for SC/ST/OBC etc.
- ii. In addition to the above, a minimum of 20% of the total seats allotted to the states are reserved for candidates belonging to Weavers Community. Shortfalls if any will be met by the candidates other than Weaver's community.

#### 6. Preparation of merit list

All the eligible Candidates who have submitted the Application Form on or before the last date specified shall be allotted a merit number.

- i. A merit List of all the eligible candidates will be prepared by the Selection Committee comprising the Director of Handlooms Textiles/Director of Industries & Director, IIHT, Jodhpur or his representative to verify the qualifying standard and other eligibility conditions depending upon the State reservation policy. A common merit list of all eligible candidates shall be submitted to IIHT Jodhpur, for the issue of offer of counselling to the eligible candidates.
- **ii.** The aggregate of marks obtained in class 10<sup>th</sup>/12<sup>th</sup> or equivalent qualifying examination shall be the basis to determine the merit for admission to first year/second year respectively.
- iii. State Government shall decide and mention the actual no. of seats to be reserved for various categories as per their prevailing reservation policy and for the weaver's community out of the total seats allotted to the state.
- iv. In the event of two candidates securing identical marks in aggregate then the candidate who had secured more marks in the Science subject will stand higher in merit.
- v. If under extraordinary circumstances the above conditions also remain identical, the eligible candidate having less age will be on higher merit. However, even if this also remains identical, the alphabetical order of the name of the candidates will be criteria for merit i.e. English alphabet A to Z.

In the case of LATERAL ENTRY, the following order of preference and methodology shall be followed.

- i. A higher percentage of marks in the subject of Mathematics at HSC;
- A higher percentage of marks in the subject Science (aggregate of physics & chemistry) at HSC;
- iii. A higher percentage of marks in the subject English at HSC;
- iv. Merit shall be determined by the date of birth, the older candidate being the senior

# 7. Counselling

i. After receiving the merit list from the State Government, The Director, of the Indian Institute of Handloom Technology Jodhpur will invite the candidates for Counselling at the Institute

itself under intimation to the concerned state government in the ratio of 1:3 of the seats allotted to the respective state.

- Counselling Committee will be comprised of the Director / Assistant Director or DDO / Senior Lecturer (TP) / Senior Lecturer (Textile) of the Indian Institute of Handloom Technology, Jodhpur and the Director of Handlooms & Textiles of the concerned State or his representative.
- iii. The candidates shall be required to produce all certificates in **original** such as educational, caste, weavers community, EWS certificate, domicile, character and medical certificate with one set of attested photocopies of all and four (4) copies of his/ her photograph identical to the one pasted on the application form at the time of counselling/ grant of admission.
- iv. A candidate who is allotted a seat will be required to pay the institute fee, immediately after confirmation of the seat. Part-payment will not be accepted. If a candidate fails to pay the fee, immediately after the seat is offered to him/her, the offer will be withdrawn and the seat will be allotted to the next candidate on the merit list.
- v. A candidate, who fails to appear in person on the notified date and time for counselling, shall forfeit his/her claim for the seat offered to him/her and such seat will be offered to the next candidate in the merit.
- vi. Vacancies arising due to cancellation/any other reasons for admission to the DHTT course will be calculated and notified. The remaining candidates of the concerned state in the merit list, who could not get a chance in 1<sup>st</sup> Counselling due to their lower position in the merit list, will be invited to 2<sup>nd</sup> counselling along with candidates in the combined merit list of all the waitlisted candidates of all the states under the jurisdiction of this Institute. (if required)
- vii. In case the seats are not filled even after the list of the eligible candidates of the state and the combined merit list of all the wait-listed candidates of all the states is exhausted then inter Institute-wise merit list of eligible candidates will be prepared and 3<sup>rd</sup> Counselling would be conducted as per the above procedure.
- viii. No TA/DA will be given to candidates for attending the counselling.

#### 8. Stipend

Each student admitted into the course, both to I year and II years under the lateral entry, will be eligible for a Monthly Stipend of Rs 2500, to be paid by central and state Government as per the guidelines, for the duration of the course (tenable for 10 months). In the case of the students from Gujarat, the state government is additionally giving the fee reimbursement and incidental expenses as per the extant guidelines approved by the state government.

- The payment of the stipend is linked to attendance and academic performance. Accordingly,
  the student must have 80% of class attendance to become eligible for the monthly stipend.
- ii. The student must not have any back paper and in special cases, one back paper is allowed.

iii. The student selected for admission will be required to submit a declaration on a non-judicial stamp- paper (Rs.100/-) duly attested by Notary in the prescribed form.
